He left the message to acquire the "Truth." Lumbini is a sacred place for Buddhists. Lumbini's visit gives spiritual peace to anyone trying to avoid violence in the world.

The Pokhara tour offers visitors to enjoy the natural beauty of the city of Pokhara, which is the most popular tourist destination in Nepal. Visiting Pokhara is an

opportunity to spend an unforgettable moment by boating on Lake Fewa, fishing on Lake Begnas, observing various caves such as the Cave of Mahendra, the Cave of Mahadev, and the Cave of Chamere (Bat), etc.

Detailed itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu (1400 m.)

After you arrive in Nepal, you land at Tribhuvan International Airport. During the flight on a clear day, you can take a look at the Himalayas. Depending on your arrival time, our representative will already be there with your name on the board. After exchanging greetings in the arrivals section, you will travel in a private vehicle to the hotel where you will be staying this evening. Day 02: Drive from Kathmandu to Chitwan: 175 km, 4-5 hours

After breakfast, you head towards Chitwan, located 175 kilometers from Kathmandu. You descend along the winding path on the banks of the Trishuli River. After reaching Chitwan, check-in at the hotel, there will be a briefing session on the activities you will carry out during your stay in Chitwan. Then you walk along the Rapti River to enjoy the sunset in the subtropical jungles of Chitwan. In the evening, you enjoy a dinner with a short cultural program that highlights the unique tribal dances of the Chitwan region.

Day 3: Jungle Safari and Wildlife Exploration in Chitwan

Today, you will spend the whole day doing jungle activities in Chitwan National Park. When you drive an elephant or jeep, you will go on a jungle safari. Then, you will see the elephants bathe with their trunks full of water. When you arrive at the elephant breeding center, you will have the opportunity to witness the love

Pray in the temples, observe the architecture of the temples, and explore surroundings of the town of Lumbini and the preserved area. At night you stay in a hotel in Bhairahawa.

Day 05: Visit Tilaurakot and drive to Pokhara

Today, you will head to Tilaurakot for sightseeing. It is the homeland of Siddhartha, therefore, a holy place for all Buddhists. From Tilaurakot, you go to Pokhara via Butwal, Palpa, and Syangja. The Siddhartha highway leads you from Butwal and takes advantage of the beauty of the natural landscapes. Traveling on curved rivers is an exciting experience for most passengers. In the evening you arrive in Pokhara where you stay in a hotel. You can visit some sites if you have time.

Day 06: Morning visit to Sarangkot and day at Pokhara Sightseeing.

Today is the most important day of your visit as you will be going to Sarangkot, a vital vantage point to see the Himalayas. Early in the morning, you will travel to Sarangkot to see the magnificent view of the Annapurna mountain range, Machhepuchhre, Himchuli, Manaslu, and many others. Day 7: Flight to Kathmandu and sightseeing tour in Patan and Bhaktapur

Patan Durbar Square is in the heart of Lalitpur. It is one of three Durbar Squares in the Kathmandu Valley, which are all a UNESCO World Heritage Site. One of its attractions is the old Royal Palace, where the Malla Kings of Lalitpur resided. After Patan we continue towards Bhaktapur, Bhaktapur Durbar Square is the Royal Palace of the old kingdom of Bhaktapur, 1400 meters above sea level. Bhaktapur also recognizes as the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Bhaktapur Durbar Square's location is in the current city of Bhaktapur. It is also known as Khwopa 13 km east of Kathmandu city center. During the tour, you can see the Nyata-Pola temple, the Golden Gate, the water jets, and the 55 Window Palaces. Today your final destination is Nagarkot, a town in Bhaktapur, which is 32 km away from Kathmandu. It is also the best vantage point for its sunrise and sunset. Nagarkot is one of the closest and most outstanding mountain views point in Kathmandu. Enjoy the sunset in the Himalayas and overnight at the hotel in Nagarkot.

Day 7: Nagarkot to Kathmandu and sightseeing tour of the Kathmandu Valley:

In the early morning, you will see the sunrise from the mighty Himalayas. Then you have breakfast, and then you go to Kathmandu; upon your arrival in Kathmandu, you will begin a guided tour of several of Kathmandu's most historical and spiritual attractions. A full-day tour of Kathmandu is an opportunity to explore great historical and religious sites in Kathmandu. Most of these places belong to the UNESCO world heritage. Some of these monuments include the historic Durbar Square in Kathmandu, the sacred Hindu temple of Pashupatinath, the famous `` Monkey Temple '' (Swayambhunath), and the Buddhist shrine (Bouddhanath), which is one of the most astounding stupas in the entire world. It is an incredible opportunity to discover the tradition, culture, and history of

Nepal. After visiting these antique palaces, temples, sights, and stupas, you will back to your hotel and have a rest. Night stay in Kathmandu.

Day 8: Everest Mountain Flight Tour and descent to the international airport

The Everest mountain flying experience is a frequent tourist activity in the Himalayas of Nepal. Today, early in the morning, you will fly for an hour over Mount Everest to get the best view of the Himalayas, this flight will take you to Mount Everest and the surrounding mountains in an hour after sitting on the plane. You can see almost all of the tallest mountains like Mt. Everest, Nuptse, Lhotse, Cho Oyu, Makalu, and Kanchenjunga, to explore. Accommodation and meals

Visa Requirements

All foreigners need a visa to enter Nepal. You can get it from a Nepalese Embassy abroad or upon your arrival in Nepal. Most people will get their visas upon arrival at Kathmandu Airport.

You will need a photo ID, and the following charges depend on:

- ❖ 15 days \$25 or comparable convertible currency
- ❖ 30 days \$40 or equivalent convertible currency
- ❖ 90 days \$100 or equal convertible currency

Cultural Considerations

For those of you visiting Nepal, we recommend cultural information to help you adjust and feel comfortable:

The dress code is important for men and women. Men and women should wear pants instead of shorts when traveling to Kathmandu. It doesn't matter to men in waistcoats, but women shouldn't be naked. Women must try to be as modest as possible.

Hindus are concerned about ritual contamination of food when touched by someone outside their caste or religion. Therefore, do not feel any exposed

cooked food and, when drinking from a container used by others, avoid touching your lips. Do not eat food with your left hand and make sure you give or receive food only with your right hand. Shoes are considered degrading, so keep them on the ground and take them off before putting your feet on anything. If you enter a Nepalese house, follow the example of your host to decide to remove your shoes, but when you enter a temple or monastery, you must remove them.

You will pass Buddhist walls, chortens, and Buddhist stupas along the way, and follow local traditions, and should turn them to your right.

Travel insurance

Travel insurance for any itinerary of our company is a condition of vacation booking. At a minimum, you must have emergency medical and repatriation insurance, which must include the cost of mountain rescue, theft, loss, damage, and clinical issues is an excellent idea for traveling to Nepal. There are a wide variety of policies available. Please read carefully the general conditions of your insurers, in particular in the vital part, which is correctly written in small print. Some policies exclude "dangerous activities" (which can include driving and riding a motorcycle, and certainly bungee jumping and rafting).

Choose a policy that covers clinical and emergency repatriation, including the evacuation of helicopters for hikers and general medical evacuation. You may prefer a policy that pays doctors or hospitals directly rather than having to spend locally and claim later. In Nepal, most clinical treatments must be paid for at delivery. If your insurance company does not make a down payment, make sure you get receipts so you can claim later.

It is essential to understand that, you will be responsible for all expenses incurred in the evacuation and repatriation procedures and that it is your responsibility to pay the costs incurred in the event of an evacuation or medical treatment. You should be fully aware of the implications of arranging your travel insurance and understand the limitations and exclusions of your policy. Please note that under certain circumstances, in medical emergencies, our company director may initiate

helicopter rescue procedures (or other necessary means) without first contacting your insurance company for approval.
